

Questioned Document Examiner Letter

February 8, 2010
Subject: Aga Khan


I have examined five (5) documents with the known handwriting and signatures of Aga Khan. For the purpose of this examination I have labeled these exhibits 'K1' through 'K5'.

Today I have compared the handwriting and signatures of Aga Khan on the 'K' documents to the signature on the questioned document, identified herein as 'Q1', to determine if the author of the handwriting and signatures on the 'K' documents was the same person who authored the signature on the questioned document: a document with the last line "I send to you and your family my best loving blessings" and a signature line of "Yours affectionately".

Based upon thorough analysis of these items, and from an application of accepted forensic document examination, tools, principles and techniques, it is my professional expert opinion that a different person authored the signature on the questioned document. Someone did indeed forge the signature of Aga Khan on the questioned document, Q1.

I am willing to testify to this fact in a court of law and I will prove to the Court that my opinion is correct. My Curriculum Vitae is attached and incorporated herein by reference.

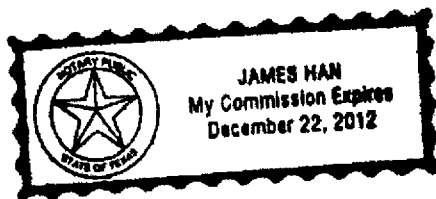
